Auntie Wang was not aware what was next to happen, that would endanger her life. However, our Heavenly Father being the Almighty God knew of the danger that lay ahead of her. Our Lord in His wisdom and love, decided to send 2 Japanese armies to knock on her two luggages just to irritate her to return home. By nature, Auntie Wang was a very strong and a very determine person. Just like John the Baptist, she was a very straight- forward person with nothing to hide and would stand up for "the truth" at all cost for Jesus. On one hand, she was full of charity towards others when mercy was required, yet on the other hand she would never budge or bow down to the enemies.

It was during the second world war in China that the Japanese armies invaded, rape and killed many of the Chinese civilians. Being the enemies of the Chinese people, the sight of the Japanese armies knocking on her two luggages only send a signal of absolute anger and irritation to Auntie Wang.

Out of the anger towards the Japanese armies for tampering her luggages, Auntie Wang decided to call off her trip and returned home. Little did she realize that she was sent home by the Lord, in order to keep her from the upcoming major disaster in her life. Soon, the news of the tragic train accident spread around like wildfire. The train that was supposed to arrive in the city of Hang Chow could not make it. Apparently, the train had plummeted along the bridge and fell straight into the river. Hundreds of people were killed and injured.

"Praise God", Auntie Wang told me." God had protected me from such a disaster!"

As I recalled this testimony and share it with you, I smile at how sweet our Heavenly Father could be towards His children. Even though Auntie Wang had gone to be with the Lord, she had left me her "voices of prayers". Her favorite prayers, when we come together to pray was always "whatever work our Lord had done and provided, is always the work that is far beyond men's expectation and comprehension!"
