THE TESTIMONIES OF GEORGE MUELLER

THE BREAKFAST OF FAITH

There were many precious Saints of the west that had contributed awesome testimonies of the Lord. Among these renown Saints were George Mueller, Hudson Taylor of England and L. Dwight Moody of United States of America. These 3 men were co-laboring for Jesus in the same era, approximately during the 19th century. Nonetheless, I would like to share with you one of the most memorable story of George Mueller. You would agree with me, that this remarkable testimony “the breakfast of faith” would indwell in your heart forever.

Brother George Mueller was a man of faith. He was known to look after as many as 1000 children in his orphanage. In his life, there was not one prayer that had not been answered. Everything he had in the orphanage was contributed and came by as a result of his prayers. In other words, George Mueller totally depended his earthly provision on the basis of “Jehovah Jireh” which means God’s provision through the power of prayers by faith.

One morning, the orphanage had nothing for breakfast to feed these many orphans. The cook was very worried and do not have any faith whatsoever. However, what brother George Mueller had was his absolute faith in our Heavenly Father. It was for certainty, that brother George Mueller had grown spiritually to know that our Heavenly Father had always been faithful to provide in the past and why not now!

As the children come together to pray on their breakfast table. The empty plates merely reflect that there was no food whatsoever and the cook nervous presence did not help either. Just as our Lord counsel us to buy “gold tried in fire”, spiritually referring to having a strong faith in the Lord in order to be rich (read Revelation 3:18), brother George Mueller faith was to be put to test once again.

George Mueller had absolute faith that God would always provide their need in time and on time. The Red Sea will only open for the Israelites, the moment they stood before it and the moment Moses rod was instructed to hit on the Red Sea. Just as Moses rod was instructed to

hit the Red Sea, Brother George Mueller began to bring everyone of the orphanage children to pray in order to thank God for their breakfast as well as to sanctify the food. As they finished their prayer, the doorbell rang and a man brought “tons of loaves of bread” came through the door to serve their breakfast table. Apparently, God had touched the man’s heart to turn to the orphanage to provide for the orphans their breakfast. How amazing that our Heavenly Father was always in time and on time on His provision for His children once again. It was not surprising that the cook was forced to resign on the basis of having no faith in the Lord’s work.

May this amazing story of George Mueller and his orphans’ breakfast encourages you to trust in the Lord through prayers in all that you do. Always keeping in mind what the Apostle Peter says:

“THAT THE TRIALS OF YOUR FAITH, BEING MUCH MORE PRECIOUS THAN OF GOLD THAT PERISHETH, THOUGH IT BE TRIED WITH FIRE, MIGHT BE FOUND UNTO PRAISE AND HONOUR AND GLORY AT THE APPEARING OF JESUS CHRIST”
