HOW DO I BEGIN TO STUDY MY BIBLE

Dearly beloved,

First and foremost, the **Holy Bible** is made up of the **Old Testament** and the **New Testament**. The New Testament is like a **new written contract**, while the Old Testament stands as the **old contract** of the Lord God. Another comparison or example of the New Testament versus the Old Testament is like having the **completed building** versus the **blueprint of building** in general. Obviously, as God's children we focus on the new written contract and enjoy living in the completed building rather than focusing on the blue print of the building or the old contract.

However, in order to completely understanding how the new contract is written and signed, we must understand how the old contract is written, isn't it?

Nonetheless, it is best to focus and read the **4 Gospels of Jesus Christ** in the **New Testament** and begin with **Matthew** chapter 1, so that you can see the '**whole picture**' of the New Testament. If you like, you may also read the Old Testament from **Genesis** together with the New Testament at the same time. There is no dogmatic rule how you read the Bible, but it only makes sense to focus on the new contract of the New Testament first and then return to understand the old contract of the Old Testament.
